Participants must supply:

- Windows Computer/Laptop capable of running the game (View specs at the Steam store link above, and test game on your rig prior to arrival at SYG)
- Headphones (Optional, but participants will either use headphones or keep their machine muted during play)
- Keyboard
- Mouse
- Controller and required peripherals (Optional, at the participant's preference)
- Monitor less than 32 inches
- All power cables
- All AV cables

SYG will supply:

- 1 x CAT 6 Ethernet cable
- 2 x power sockets (1x console, 1x monitor)
- 1 x seat and 1/2 a standard fold up table space
- Internet connection



FAQ

Is Windows PC the only accepted console?

Yes. In the interest of reliable and stable game connection, the Indie LAN team has requested that only Windows PCs are used. Xbox One, PS4, Apple Mac, and SteamOS copies of the game *will not* be used.

When and where do I bring my computer and gear?

Computers and gear are to be signed in on Friday night between 7 and 10pm at the Exhibition Building. Participants playing Saturday morning are to setup Friday night and pack up before the afternoon session on Saturday. Each participant will be assigned a number with a corresponding floor space in the Exhibition Building for storage. The participant is the only person who can sign out their computer and gear. The Exhibition Building will be locked overnight.
