SUNDAY MESSAGE RECAP

Once we have been deeply impacted by Jesus, it's time to share the Good News and make a difference in the world. Continuing from the story of Jesus walking on the water, let's discuss how we can actively impact others. Below are some more helpful verses to look at:

Ephesians 2:8 NLT

8 God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God.

Paul is clear here that we can't speak of this glorious work without reminding us it's a gift, given to the undeserving.

2 Corinthians 3:17 NLT

17 For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

Important to know that the Holy Spirit is God, just as Jesus and the Father are God. We have freedom because of the presence of the Holy Spirit.
