



Day Visitor Policy

Updated January 26, 2022.

State Youth Games (SYG) prioritises the safety and comfort of its participants. In order to do so, SYG reserves the right to record the presence of all individuals who come onto the SYG event grounds.

To ensure that SYG can be confident of a safe environment for all participants, day visitors are required to adhere to the following policy items. If these requirements are not met, the visitor will be asked to leave the event.

1. A 'day visitor' is an SYG participant that attends Lardner Park or an SYG venue during the SYG event period for no more than 24 hours, and does not stay overnight at Lardner Park.
2. Wherever possible, day visitors should be registered with the group they are visiting before arrival at SYG.
 - a. Registration is handled through the same registration platform as participant registrations.
3. Day visitors aged 18 years or older are subject to the *State Youth Games Code of Conduct (Participants Aged 18 and Over)*. Breaches of the Code of Conduct may result in removal from the event.
 - a. Day visitors that are aged 18 years or older must hold a valid Victorian Working With Children Check (WWCC) card.
4. Day visitors aged 17 years or younger are subject to the *State Youth Games Code of Conduct (For Participants Under 18)*. Breaches of the Code of Conduct may result in removal from the event.
